

“Save a Trip Win a Trip” Sweepstakes

OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS SWEEPSTAKES. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

- 1. How to Enter:** The “Save a Trip Win a Trip” Sweepstakes (“Sweepstakes”) begins at 12:01 a.m. (Pacific Time [“PT”]) on June 1, 2004 and ends at 11:59 p.m. (PT) on June 30, 2004 (“Sweepstakes Period”). Two ways to enter: 1) **Online Entry:** To enter, log on to your online banking session at your participating financial institution’s website, click the banner ad located on your Account Summary/Account Access page and submit the online entry form for the Sweepstakes in accordance with the on-screen directions during the Sweepstakes Period. If you are not already registered for online banking with your financial institution, you must first register for online banking before you can enter the Sweepstakes online; or 2) **Mail Entry:** On a plain 3” x 5” card, legibly handprint or type your name, age, complete address, city, state, zip code, home and business phone numbers (including area code), email address (if any) and your participating financial institution’s name (if any). Then, mail your 3” x 5” card in a postage-affixed sealed envelope to: “Save a Trip Win a Trip” Sweepstakes, 1878 East Avenue, Rochester, NY 14610. Limit of one (1) entry per person, regardless of the manner of entry (whether online or via mail). No mechanically or programmatically reproduced entries permitted. Each envelope is considered one entry. All Online Entries must be received by 11:59 p.m. (PT) on June 30, 2004. Mail entries must be postmarked by June 30, 2004 and received by July 9, 2004. Neither Digital Insight Corporation (“Sponsor”) nor The National Sweepstakes Company (“Sweepstakes Administrator”) will verify receipt of entries. All entries submitted become the sole property of Sponsor and will not be returned. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, misdirected or damaged mailed entries.
- 2. Eligibility:** To enter the Sweepstakes, you must be a lawful permanent resident of the United States, 18 years of age or older and must not be considered a minor in your state of residence. Sweepstakes is void in Puerto Rico, U.S. territories and possessions, outside of the United States, and where restricted or prohibited by law. Employees of Sponsor, their affiliated companies, parents, subsidiaries, service partners, and advertising and promotion agencies (collectively, “Sweepstakes Entities”), and their IRS dependents, immediate families (parents, children, siblings, spouse) and members of their households (whether related or not) are ineligible to participate in this Sweepstakes.

Drawing and Notification:** Potential winners will be selected from all eligible entries received and/or credited in a random drawing held on or about July 16, 2004 by The National Sweepstakes Company, an independent judging organization, whose decisions are final and binding in all respects. In the event of a dispute as to the identity of an online entrant, the entrant will be deemed to be the holder of the applicable financial institution account accessed in each applicable online banking session. In the event there is more than one holder of such account then the first person named on the account shall be deemed to be the entrant. Odds of winning a prize depends on the number of eligible entries received. The potential winners will be notified by phone, email or mail. If a potential winner cannot be reached within four (4) days from the first notification attempt, then such person shall be disqualified and an alternate winner will be selected. All prizes will be awarded.
- 4. Prizes: One (1) Grand Prize:** Weekend trip (Friday-Sunday) for two (2) to winner’s choice of any destination in the 50 United States. Trip includes round-trip coach class airfare from major airport nearest winner’s home to location selected by winner, 3 days/2 nights first-class hotel accommodations (double occupancy) and round-trip airport to hotel transfers. All other trip related expenses (i.e., room service, telephone charges, etc.) are the responsibility of the winner. Approximate Retail Value [ARV] \$2,500.

Hundreds of Financial Institution Prizes: One (1) brand name DVD Player will be awarded at each participating financial institution. The ARV of each financial institution prize is \$70. Total ARV for all Financial Institution Prizes will be determined by the number of participating financial institutions.

The Grand Prize Winner is not eligible to also win one of the randomly drawn Financial Institution Prizes. Winners will be responsible for all federal, state or other tax liabilities (including income taxes) arising from prizes won in this Sweepstakes.
