The Cloudbleed bug involves Cloudflare, which provides services to millions of popular websites across the web including Uber, Yelp, and others. This bug has caused passwords, cookies and other data to temporarily be available in plain text.

Does this bug impact CBC members?

How can you protect yourself?

- Even if this leak does not directly affect you, it is a good opportunity to update your passwords to be more secure.
- Here are some password Do's and Don'ts:
 - Stay away from easy-to-guess passwords ("123456" or "password")
 - Don't use easy identifiers like your dog's name
 - Include a mix of numbers, letters, and symbols
 - The longer the password the better
 - Try not to use the same password for multiple accounts
